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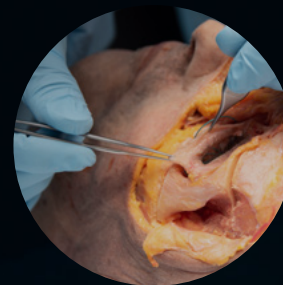

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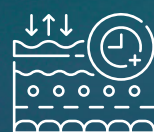

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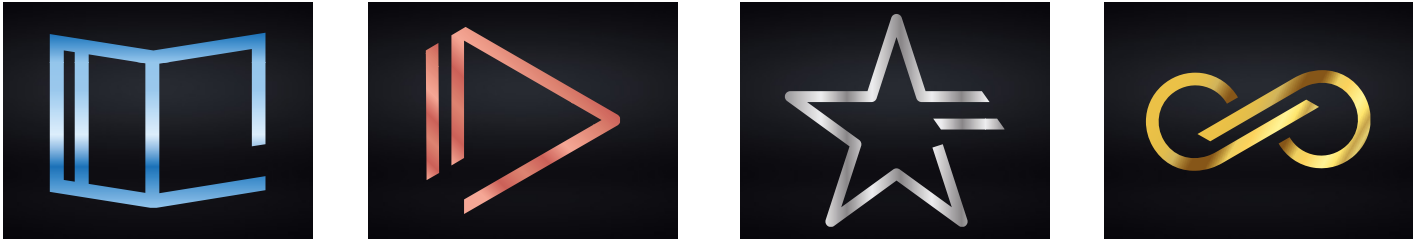

VOLUME 1 PUBLISHED 2024

Volume 1 marked the beginning of a new kind of publication in aesthetic medicine. It looked beyond techniques and trends to explore how and why we practice. The issue brought together reflections on ethics, artistry, science, and professional identity, inviting readers to engage with the deeper questions that shape clinical work. One of its standout features was a behind-the-scenes look at the IMCAS Anatomy on Cadaver Workshops, a signature session of the congress that brings live dissection, expert commentary, and real-time anatomical insight to the forefront of medical education.

"Before any application on living subjects, mastering techniques on anatomical specimens is essential. It sets the foundation for the responsibility of applying these skills to patients who entrust us with their care."

At Fer à Moulin, dissection is more than demonstration. It is the foundation of the IMCAS Anatomy on Cadaver Workshops, a hands-on program that blends academic precision with real clinical relevance. Each cadaver session is structured to reflect the scientific themes of the congress, whether focused on facial aging, filler safety, or surgical technique. Sessions are supported by live commentary and close-up footage to reinforce anatomical understanding in real time.

"The dissections follow a strict protocol," says Dr. Kestemont. "We plan them like surgeries, with a defined objective, anatomical focus, and didactic structure. It is not improvisation. It is education."

Prof. Sinna explains that the goal is not just to show anatomy, but to contextualize it. "We reveal what is typically hidden during procedures. The deep fat compartments. The course of a risky artery. The tension planes beneath the skin. These are the elements that determine success or failure, especially in areas like the midface or temple."

The article emphasizes that anatomy is not fixed. It changes with age, movement, and intervention. The ability to observe it clearly and teach it effectively is what defines the Fer à Moulin method and what continues to make these workshops essential for any serious practitioner.

VOLUME 2 PUBLISHED 2025

Ultrasound has steadily risen in popularity over the past few years. Leading experts agree that once you begin using ultrasound in your practice, it is difficult to go back. The level of detail it provides for procedural planning, safety, and complication management makes it an essential tool in modern aesthetic medicine.

From identifying vascular structures and filler placement to assessing skin thickness and tissue integrity, ultrasound offers real-time clarity that translates into safer outcomes. In clinical settings, it is now used for injection guidance, filler detection, inflammation assessment, and even skin cancer diagnostics.

This report explores handheld, tablet-based, and high-end ultrasound systems, with an emphasis on features most relevant to aesthetic needs. Portability, imaging depth, frequency range, and probe design are all considered. Side-by-side comparisons help practitioners choose the right fit based on clinical application and budget.

As adoption grows, ultrasound is no longer a luxury. It is becoming a standard of care. This article not only showcases devices but also reminds readers that success with ultrasound depends on operator skill, training, and an understanding of anatomy. The right device is important, but how it is used matters even more.

VOLUME 3 RELEASING JANUARY 2026

Volume 3 offers the kind of conversations that are rarely captured in lectures or scientific papers. It brings together thoughtful voices from across disciplines to reflect on clinical responsibility, patient psychology, and the changing expectations placed on practitioners today. Alongside contributions from the Innovation Tank and NextGen Derm programs, the issue continues its product analysis series with a comparative look at picosecond lasers. One of the edition's most candid reads is a dialogue between two experts on off-label use, where experience, safety, and honesty take center stage.

EXCERPT FROM "OFF-LABEL, ON POINT" BY PROF. BERTHOLD RZANY AND DR. JEREMY GREEN

Off-label use is nothing new in aesthetics. It has always been part of the practice. When botulinum toxin was first introduced, the only approved indication was for glabellar lines. Even then, physicians were already exploring other areas. That spirit of exploration has not changed. What has changed is how much more we know and how much more is expected of us.

The cornerstone of any off-label use is safety. That might seem obvious, but it is often where the conversation needs to begin. If there is no data or only limited literature, that does not mean the treatment has no value. It simply means it demands caution. A clear understanding of anatomy is essential. Start with low doses. Try new approaches first on people you know and trust. Never on patients. Being first does not excuse being careless. Real expertise comes from careful, consistent clinical work and a willingness to share both the successes and the missteps. Protocols are useful. Guidelines are welcome. But in many areas of aesthetic medicine, they do not yet exist or are written by people who have never treated the indication in question. Off-label use will always require more from us – more responsibility, more thought, more humility. That is exactly why it should remain part of our practice.
