Across all of IMCAS platforms participants are expected to maintain the same high standards that we apply towards our scientific programs.

Core principles

The following behaviours are expected and requested from all Event Participants:

- Behaving in a courteous and professional, respectful manner
- Treating everyone with dignity and consideration, valuing a diversity of views and opinions
- Refraining from demeaning, discriminatory, or harassing behaviour and speech

Scientific Integrity and Content Use

- Brand, product, or device names cited only in a comparative context in scientific and granted lectures
- Educational purpose is primary - presentations grounded in real evidence: data, methodology, or outcomes
- No redistribution of IMCAS-derived material outside the platform without written consent from the organizers
- No reuse of another speaker's data, images, or material, published or not, without explicit permission from them or proper citation of their work
